Mixing and Feeding Guide

Remember: Individual animals vary in requirements. Adjust amounts according to your judgement.

For best mixing, mix powder with warm water (100 degrees F). Enclosed cup holds 4 ounces by weight (113 grams) dry powder.

Using the plastic cup enclosed in each bag, add the following amount of powder to 1 quart of warm water:

Feeding Schedule for Lambs and Kids

Day 1	3-4	None, feed colostrum-1 pt
Day 2-10	3-4	1-1/2 pt
Day 11-weaning	2-3	1 quart

Feeding Schedule for Foals

Day 1	2-3	Colostrum only-feed 4 qt Ensure 1-2 quarts within 12 hours of birth
0-1 week	4	2 quarts

Day 6-10	Free-Choice-Ad-Lib	3-5 pints
Day 11-15	Free-Choice-Ad-Lib	5-8 pints
Day 16-21	Free-Choice-Ad-Lib	8-12 pints

Day 1-4	2-3	None, feed colostrum 4 qt.
Day 5-weaning	3	4-5 quarts

NOT FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION

Dry Powder Supplement Directions:

DOGS: As a supplement for puppies, pregnant and lactating bitches, show animals and active adults, mix 2 tablespoons per 5 lb of body weight into daily ration.

FOALS: Mix or top-dress 4 ounces (one enclosed cup) into daily dry creep feed ration to improve feed intake and provide supplemental nutrients. Gradually increase amount to 2 measures daily and continue feeding until weaned.

PIGS: Mix or top-dress 4 ounces (one enclosed cup) per lb of creep feed to provide supplemental milk proteins to these diets. Continue through the weaning period at this rate.

LAMBS & KIDS: Mix or top-dress 2 ounces (1/2 enclosed cup) per lb of dry starter feed to improve feed intake and provide supplemental nutrients.
